

Troop 110 Annual Halloween Campout

When: Beginning at 2:30 p.m., October 25 (Saturday) & ending at 11:00 a.m. October 26 (Sunday)

Where: Cameron's Inn/ Restaurant, Half Moon Bay.

Description: This is a one night campout at a private park, adjacent to an English Restaurant Pub. The facilities are very convenient. There is a big campfire area, a stage for skits, and several tables for cooking and eating. Parking is free. The troop will set up camp and organize many activities. Patrols will do all the cooking, and prepare dinner and breakfast.

On Saturday evening, there will be a campfire program which will include a flag retirement ceremony. All Scouts and Scouters should wear their class A uniforms. After the campfire, Scouts may choose to watch a movie in the clubhouse.

Adults not wishing to eat with the Scouts may eat in the restaurant and enjoy Cameron's hospitality. There is karaoke on a special stage along with other games such a pool and shuffleboard. Plus, it's the weekend before Halloween and several patrons will be in costume!

Requirements that can be earned will center on cooking. Patrols should prepare complete meals (see your handbook and merit badge book). The campfire ring also allows us to use Dutch Ovens! Peach and cherry cobblers will be made by the junior leadership. The troop will cook a variety of food, including non-meat dishes.

What to Bring: All Scouts and campers should bring standard personal camping gear. While the troop has a few extra tents, guests should bring their own tent if possible, and a sleeping bag and a good mat. It does get cold at night, so be sure to bring warm clothing.

Cost: Troop 110 Scouts, siblings and adults should expect a cost of \$17.00 (approximately) per person. The troop will host a group of Cub Scouts and their parents.

Directions: From the East Bay, take highway 92 west to Half Moon Bay. At highway 1, turn left – heading south – and continue for two miles. Cameron's is on the right side of the highway. Look for the two red English double decker buses in the parking lot.
